HISTORIC CHURCHES CYCLE RIDE

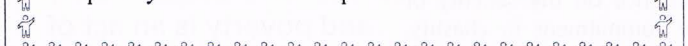


This takes place next Saturday, 14th September, between 9 am and 5 pm.
