

PROPOSED AMENDMENT OF THE PPC CONSTITUTION

At the recommendation of the most recent meeting of the PPC of St Edmund's Parish, it is proposed that, subject to confirmation by the AGM of the Parish in July 2018, the following words should be added to the Constitution in the appropriate place to take immediate effect:

“The representatives, but not necessarily the officials, should stand down from the PPC for at least two years when they have served for two terms, ie for four years. Within that time-frame, an individual who is an official may simultaneously serve as a representative”.
